

Multiplication Word Problems



Use the picture above to answer the questions.
Write the answer in the form of a number sentence.

Example: $2 \times 5 = 10$

1 The Ferris wheel costs 5 tickets to ride. How many tickets does it cost for 5 people to ride?

$$5 \times 5 = 25$$

4 An ice cream cone costs \$3. How much will 5 children spend buying ice cream cones?

$$3 \times 5 = 18$$

2 The roller coaster cars hold 2 people each. How many can 10 roller coaster cars hold?

$$2 \times 10 = 20$$

5 There are 4 people who play the ball toss. Each game costs 5 tickets. How many tickets are used?

$$4 \times 5 = 20$$

3 There are 5 children who bought balloons. Each child bought 2 balloons. How many balloons in all did they buy?

$$5 \times 2 = 10$$

6 There are 6 people who sell balloons in the park. If they each have 5 balloons, how many balloons are there in all?

$$6 \times 5 = 30$$
