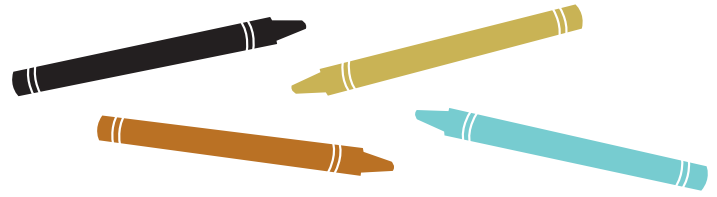

1. There are 36 students in 4th grade. There are 22 girls and 14 boys. What fraction of the students are girls?

$$\frac{22}{36}$$

2. There are 48 crayons in a crayon box. Then 14 of them spilled out of the box. What fraction of the crayons spilled out of the box?

$$\frac{14}{48}$$

3. Out of the 36 students, 15 students play dodgeball at recess. What fraction of the students play dodgeball at recess?

$$\frac{15}{36}$$

4. There are 10 students wearing red shirts, 12 students wearing blue shirts, and 14 students wearing multi-colored shirts. What fraction of the students are wearing blue shirts?

$$\frac{12}{36}$$

Challenge:

Out of the 36 students, 19 students take music lessons. The rest of the students take art lessons. What fraction of the students take art lessons?

$$\frac{17}{36}$$
