The artist painted a scene with realistic, three-dimensional shapes and figures, focusing on an individual posed as if he were about to move.	Michelangelo	Prophet Joel
The artist celebrated ancient Greek and Roman philosophers and relied on newly discovered artistic methods such as linear perspective and a vanishing point to emphasize the depth in his painting.	Raphael	The School of Athens
The artist used vibrant colors to create idealized, almost angelic, figures from classical mythology in a garden setting celebrating spring.	Sandro Botticelli	Primavera
