
It's Grammar Time Answer Key Possessive Nouns

A possessive noun shows ownership.

NOUN	MAKE POSSESSIVE BY	EXAMPLE
SINGULAR	add an apostrophe and -s	snacks of the girl 🔶 the girl's snacks
PLURAL	add an apostrophe	snacks of the girls \longrightarrow the girls' snacks
