

Jump-A-Round

Rounding numbers is like jumping to the nearest ten or nearest hundred.



When the number has a 1, 2, 3, or 4 in the <u>ones</u> place, it is rounded DOWN to the nearest ten. When the number has a 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 in the ones place, it is rounded UP to the nearest ten. For example, 6 can be rounded up to 10.


