


Which Angle Is It?

A right angle equals 90 degrees.

An acute angle is less than 90 degrees.

An obtuse angle is between 90 and 180 degrees.

Look at the angles in the shapes below. Label them as right, acute, or obtuse angles. See the example. Note: If you are unsure whether something is a right angle, take a piece of paper, or a book, and place one of its corners inside that angle. If it fits neatly inside, it is a right angle.



angle ABC	right	angle HGE	<u>right</u>
angle EFG	obtuse	angle BCE	right
angle EGH	<u>right</u>	angle GCH	acute
angle ECG	acute	angle FGE	acute
angle AED	<u>right</u>	angle DAB	acute
