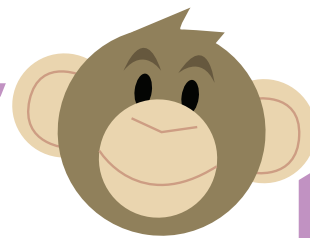

Letters Before Y



When a noun has a consonant before the y, drop the y and add *ies* to make the word plural. When a noun ends in a vowel+y, simply add an s to make it plural.

Determine the letters before y in the words below, then make the plural form.

Singular form	Letter before y	Consonant (c) or Vowel (v)	Plural form
Example: city	t	c	cities
toy	o	v	toys
fly	l	c	flies
story	r	c	stories
baby	b	c	babies
key	e	v	keys
party	t	c	parties
boy	o	v	boys
country	r	c	countries
monkey	e	v	monkeys
tray	a	v	trays
