

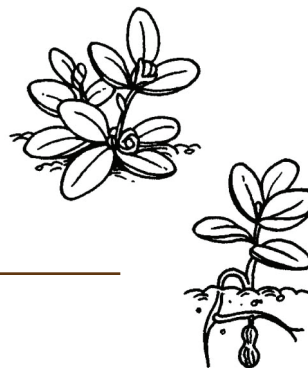
THE LIFE CYCLE OF A PEANUT PLANT



In spite of its name, the peanut is not a nut. It is a legume. Beans, peas, and lentils are other types of legumes. Learn about the life cycle of the peanut through the activities below.
