Circle all the words that have a long vowel sound. Draw a line to connect each long vowel with the word that makes its sound. (Hint: you may have to connect more than one word with any given vowel sound!) Now go back and place an **X** over all the words that don't belong.

Can you think of another word with a long vowel sound? Answers will vary.

The matching exercise consists of the following items:

- Vowel A:** Connected to "table". Words "can" and "sled" are crossed out.
- Vowel E:** Connected to "whale" and "tree". Word "ship" is crossed out.
- Vowel I:** Connected to "knife" and "peach". Word "dog" is crossed out.
- Vowel O:** Connected to "bike" and "goat". Word "bus" is crossed out.
- Vowel U:** Connected to "suit" and "blue".

Words that do not contain the long vowel sound and are crossed out: can, sled, dog, bus.
