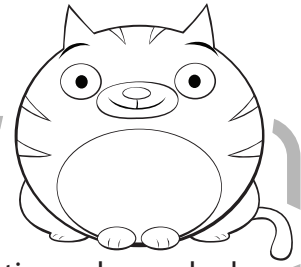


Looking at Character Actions
