Read each excerpt that is imaginary. Think about how you can write a new, realistic sentence and then write your sentence on the line. The first one is done for you.

Example:

5. As I gazed into the backyard, I was amazed to see money growing on the bushes around the house.

Realistic Sentence: **Beautiful pink flowers grew on the bushes around our house.**
