Solution Vincent found a new scooter for \$64, but he waited until it went on sale to buy it. If he bought the scooter for \$56, what was the percent markdown?

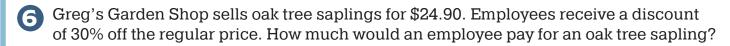

At the bakery Lola owns, the cost of baking and decorating a cake is \$17. Lola marks up cakes by 120% before selling them. How much does the bakery charge for a cake?
