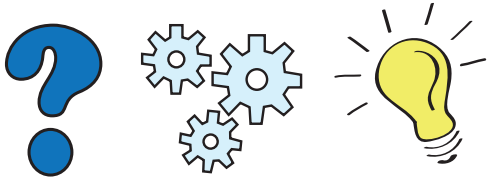


Multiplication Problem Solving Strategies

one table / with four chairs
