Repeated Addition 2

Directions: Find the total by writing both repeated addition and multiplication equations.

Example

Find the total number of legs on these five, furry cats.



Repeated addition sentence: 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 = 20 legs

Multiplication sentence: $5 \times 4 = 20 \text{ legs}$

Now you try!


1. Find the total number of petals on the flowers.



Repeated addition sentence: 5 + 5 + 5 = 15 petals

Multiplication sentence: $3 \times 5 = 15$ petals

2. Find the total number of pieces of candy in the candy jar.



Addition sentence: 3 + 3 + 3 + 3 + 3 + 3 = 18 pieces of candy

Multiplication sentence: $6 \times 3 = 18$ pieces of candy
