MULTIPLICATION WORD PROBLEMS CHECK-IN

Directions: Solve the problems below. Be sure to show your work!

1. A box of crayons holds 8 crayons. If Jackson has 4 boxes, how many crayons does he have?

$$8 \times 4 = 32 \text{ crayons}$$

2. A motorcycle has 2 wheels. How many wheels are on 9 motorcycles?

$$2 \times 9 = 18 \text{ wheels}$$

3. Molly ran 5 miles a day. How many miles did she run in one week?

$$5 \times 7 = 35 \text{ miles}$$

4. There are 3 bunches of bananas. Each bunch has 6 bananas. How many bananas are there in all?

$$3 \times 6 = 18 \text{ bananas}$$

5. The babysitter earned \$5 an hour. She worked for 4 hours. How much money did she earn?

$$5 \times 4 = \$20$$

6. Each table in the classroom has 4 students. There are 6 tables in the classroom. How many students are there altogether?

$$4 \times 6 = 24 \text{ students}$$

7. Bryson wants to give each person in his family 2 gifts for the holiday. There are 3 people in his family. How many gifts will he give?

$$2 \times 3 = 6 \text{ gifts}$$

8. There are 6 apple trees in the yard. Each tree has 7 apples that are ready to be picked. How many apples are ready to be picked?

$$6 \times 7 = 42 \text{ apples}$$

9. There are five boxes of pencils. Each box has 10 pencils inside. How many pencils are there altogether?

$$5 \times 10 = 50 \text{ pencils}$$

10. Parker's vegetable garden has six rows of plants. Each row has eight plants. How many plants are there in the vegetable garden?

$$6 \times 8 = 48 \text{ plants}$$
