4. There are 3 bunches of bananas. Each bunch has 6 bananas. How many bananas are there in all?

$$
3 \times 6=18 \text { bananas }
$$

5. The babysitter earned $\$ 5$ an hour. She worked for 4 hours. How much money did she earn?

$$
5 \times 4=\$ 20
$$

6. Each table in the classroom has 4 students. There are 6 tables in the classroom. How many students are there altogether?

$$
4 \times 6=24 \text { students }
$$

7. Bryson wants to give each person in his family 2 gifts for the holiday. There are 3 people in his family. How many gifts will he give?

$$
2 \times 3=6 \mathrm{gifts}
$$

8. There are 6 apple trees in the yard. Each tree has 7 apples that are ready to be picked. How many apples are ready to be picked?

$$
6 \times 7=42 \text { apples }
$$

9. There are five boxes of pencils. Each box has 10 pencils inside. How many pencils are there altogether?

$$
5 \times 10=50 \text { pencils }
$$

10. Parker's vegetable garden has six rows of plants. Each row has eight plants. How many plants are there in the vegetable garden?

$$
6 \times 8=48 \text { plants }
$$
