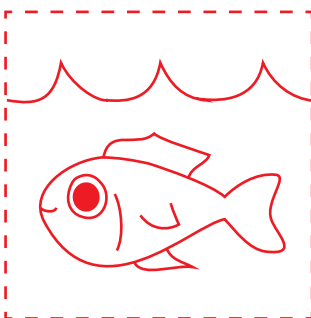
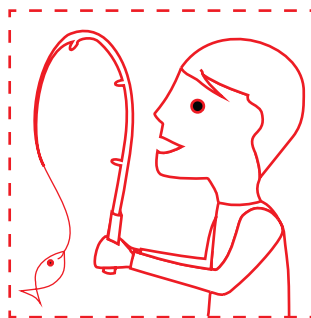
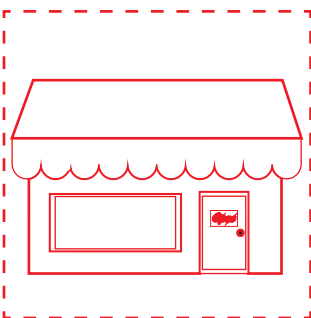
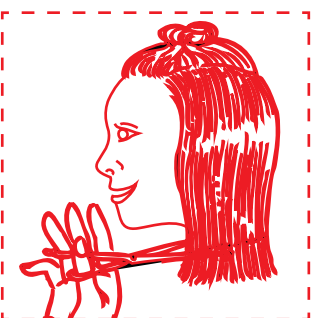
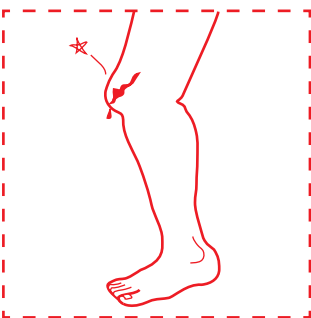
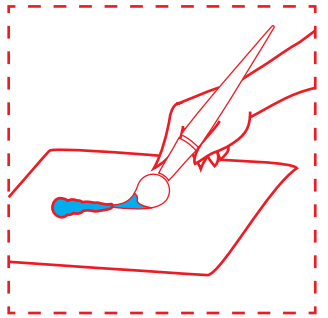
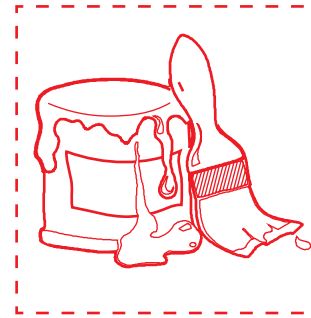
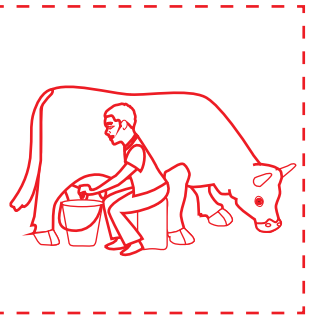
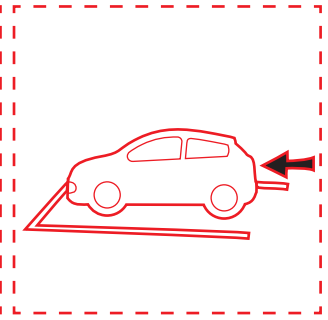
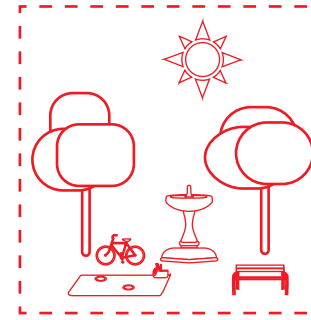
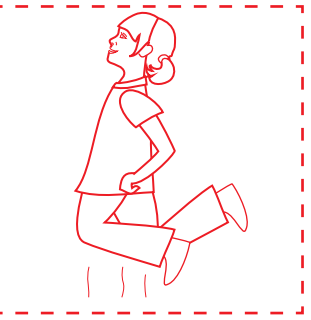
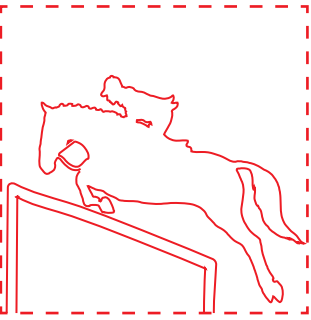
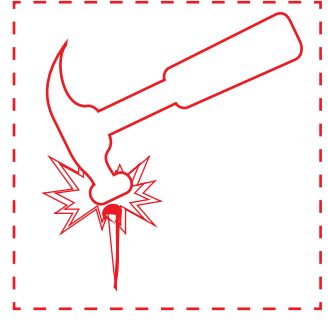
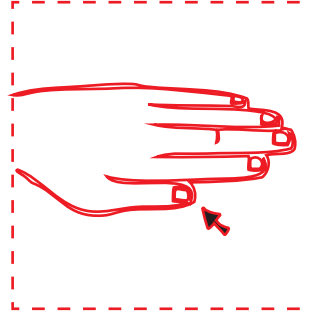
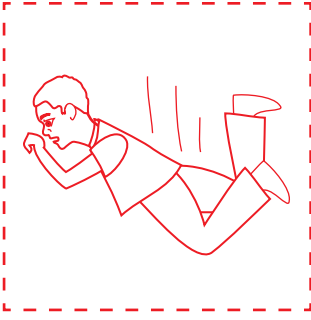
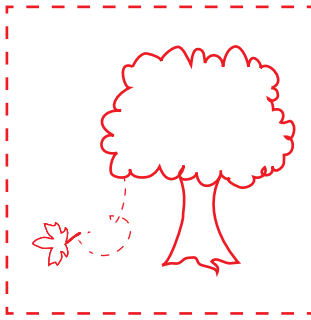
Nouns and verbs are different kinds of words. Nouns are words that name people, places, and things. Verbs are words that show action. Sometimes a word can be both a noun and a verb!
