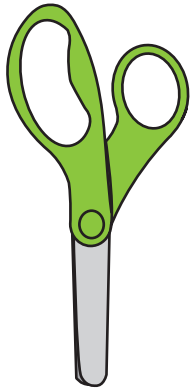

# Open and Closed Syllable Sort



Read each word at the bottom of the page. Separate each word into syllables by drawing a slash mark (/) between the syllables. Then cut out each word and glue it under the correct heading.

**Open Syllable:** Occurs when a vowel is at the end of a syllable, which results in the vowel making the long sound as in “o/pen.”

**Closed Syllable:** Occurs when a syllable ends with a consonant, which results in the vowel making the short sound as in “rob/in.”
