It is generally served with a slice of sweet potato and cancha, or toasted corn kernels. One of the main indigenous groups of Perú is the Inca. The Inca built many cities, temples and monuments with highly skilled stonemasonry. One of the seven wonders of the world is "Machu Picchu" found in Cuzco, the capital of the Incan empire. The national animal of Perú is the vicuña. Vicuñas are related to llamas and camels.
