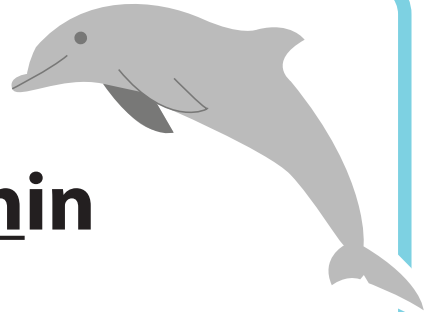


Phonics Review: Digraphs: ph

A **digraph** is a combination of two letters that make one sound.







Example: **ph** has the same sound as **f**
