

## Answer Key Prefix Pond

Look at all of the words in the prefix pond. Sort out the words and write the words that go together. Underline the prefix in each word. Next, explain what each word means in the second column. Underline the part that shows the meaning of the prefix.



What is the meaning of the word, considering the prefix?

Example:	<u>uni</u> cycle	A unicycle is like a bicycle, but only has <u>one</u> wheel.
Similar Word:	<u>uni</u> form	A uniform is <u>one</u> type of clothing for a group of people.

What is the meaning of the word, considering the prefix?

Word 1: <u>ill</u> egal	If something is illegal, it is not legal. It is against the law.
Similar Word: <u>ill</u> egible	You can not read illegible handwriting because it is messy.

What is the meaning of the word, considering the prefix?

Word 2: <u>after</u> noon	This time is following noon.
Similar Word: afterthought	This is a thought that you have following an event or other thought.

What is the meaning of the word, considering the prefix?

Word 3: <u>a</u> board	If you go aboard, you go on board
Similar Word: <u>a</u> shore	An example is a shell that washes on the shore.
