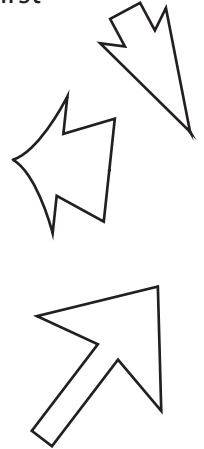
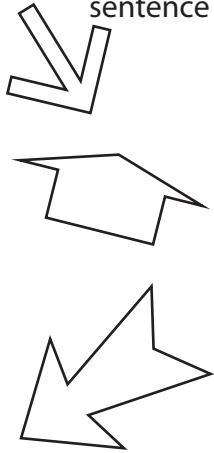

**Example:**

Prepositional Phrase: **for thirty minutes**

1. Prepositional Phrase: **with her**  
Sentence: **Maria went with her to go shopping for new curtains.**
2. Prepositional Phrase: **throughout the day**

3. Prepositional Phrase: **inside the house**  
Sentence: **Mom told the boys not to run inside the house.**

5. Prepositional Phrase: **until 8:00**  
Sentence: **The arts and crafts store is open until 8:00 p.m.**
6. Prepositional Phrase: **due to the rain**  
Sentence: **Due to the rain, the field trip to the zoo will be cancelled.**
7. Prepositional Phrase: **to the city**  
Sentence: **My family decided to take a trip to the city during our spring break.**
8. Prepositional Phrase: **for her**  
Sentence: **I bought a new purse as a birthday present for her.**
