## **Present Tense Verbs: Final Letter Clues**

If a verb ends with a *vowel* before -y, add -s for the third person present tense (happening now). If a verb ends with a *consonant* 

before -y, remove the -y and add -ies. Consider the final letters of each verb, then change it to the correct third person present tense.

Verb	Is the letter before -y a vowel (v) or consonant (c)?	Third person present tense
Example: say	V	says
annoy	V	annoys
cry	С	cries
destroy	V	destroys
dry	С	dries
hurry	С	hurries
рау	V	pays
say	V	says
spy	С	spies
stay	V	stays
study	С	studies
