

## PRONOUNS IN COMPOUND SUBJECTS AND OBJECTS #2

When we use pronouns in compound subjects or objects, it can be hard to tell which pronoun is correct. You can try looking at the sentence without the other noun to help you decide whether to use the subject or object pronoun.



**Example:** Last summer, (she/her) and Lena took a pottery class at the community center.

Last summer, she took a pottery class at the community center.

**Example:** The tour guide showed (he/him) and Miles the entrance to the hidden stairway.

The tour guide showed him the entrance to the hidden stairway.
