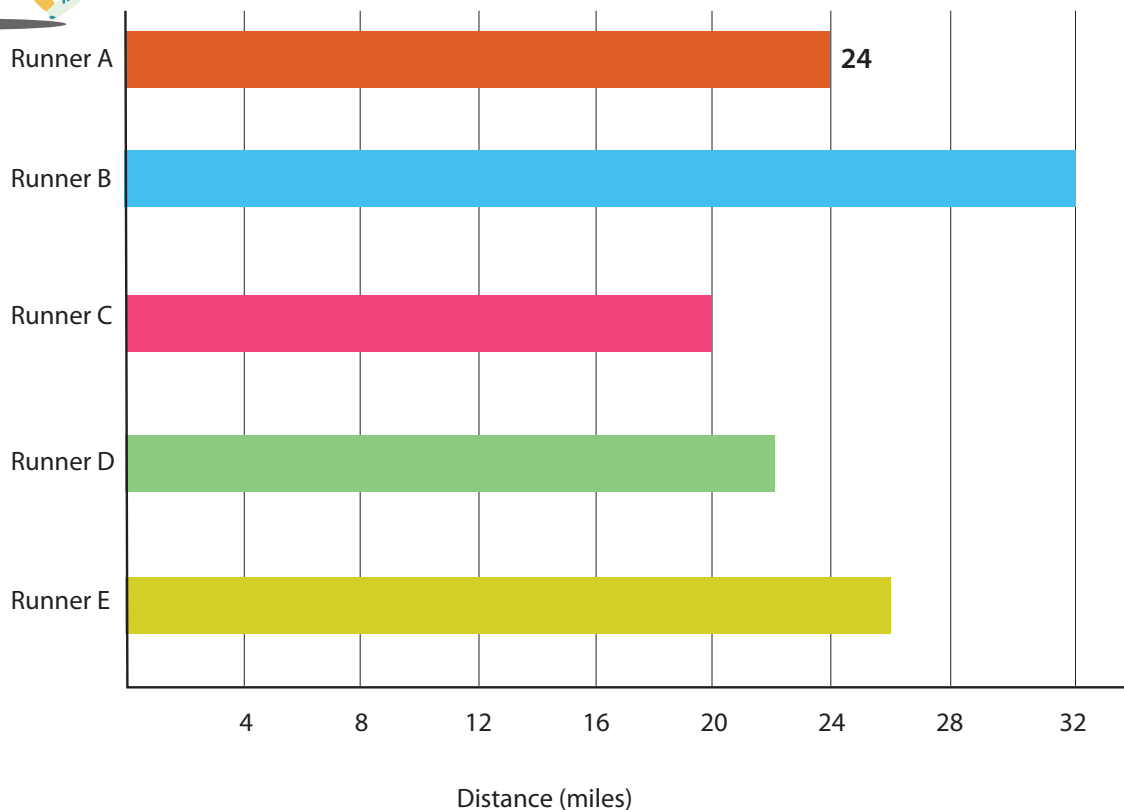




# Go Runners!: Practice Reading a Bar Graph
