
Adjectives: ANSWERS

Adjectives are modifiers; they describe nouns and pronouns. In a sentence diagram, the nouns, pronouns and verbs are placed in the top row, and the adjectives are placed on a diagonal line under the noun or pronoun they describe. Articles (the, a, an) are also a type of adjective.



Some nouns have more that one adjective as modifiers. These adjectives are called compound adjectives. To diagram sentences with compound adjectives, put the adjectives together under the noun they modify. Place any conjunctions for the compound adjectives on a dotted line between the adjectives.
