Shades of Meaning: Which Word?

Some words are alike and have small differences in meaning. These differences are called **shades of meaning**. Think about the words **surprise** and **startle**.

Both words mean to cause something unexpected to happen, but in different ways.

If you **surprise** someone, you cause something unexpected to happen, usually in a good way.

If you **startle** someone, you cause something unexpected to happen, usually in a bad way.

It's more enjoyable to be surprised.
