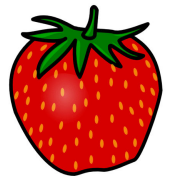


# Easy Math Word Problems #3



Fresh fruit salad anyone?

Use addition or subtraction to solve the word problems.

## Fruit Salad #1

Let's make a fruit salad! Put 5 grapes in a bowl. Add 6 pieces of watermelon. Put 3 cut-up strawberries in the bowl. Finally, add 4 slices of banana. How much fruit is in the bowl altogether?

$$5 + 6 + 3 + 4 = 18$$

## Fruit Salad #2

How about a different version? Put 12 melon balls in a bowl. Add 8 slices of orange and 14 blueberries. How much fruit is there altogether?

$$12 + 8 + 14 = 34$$

## Fruit Salad #3

This fruit salad has already been put together but it has too many raspberries. There are 16 raspberries but you want only 9. How much less raspberries do you need?

$$16 - \underline{\quad} = 9$$

## Fruit Salad #4

This fruit salad is already made as well. It has lots of good fruit but not enough grapes. There are only 6 grapes and you would like 18. How many more grapes do you need?

$$6 + \underline{\quad} = 18$$
