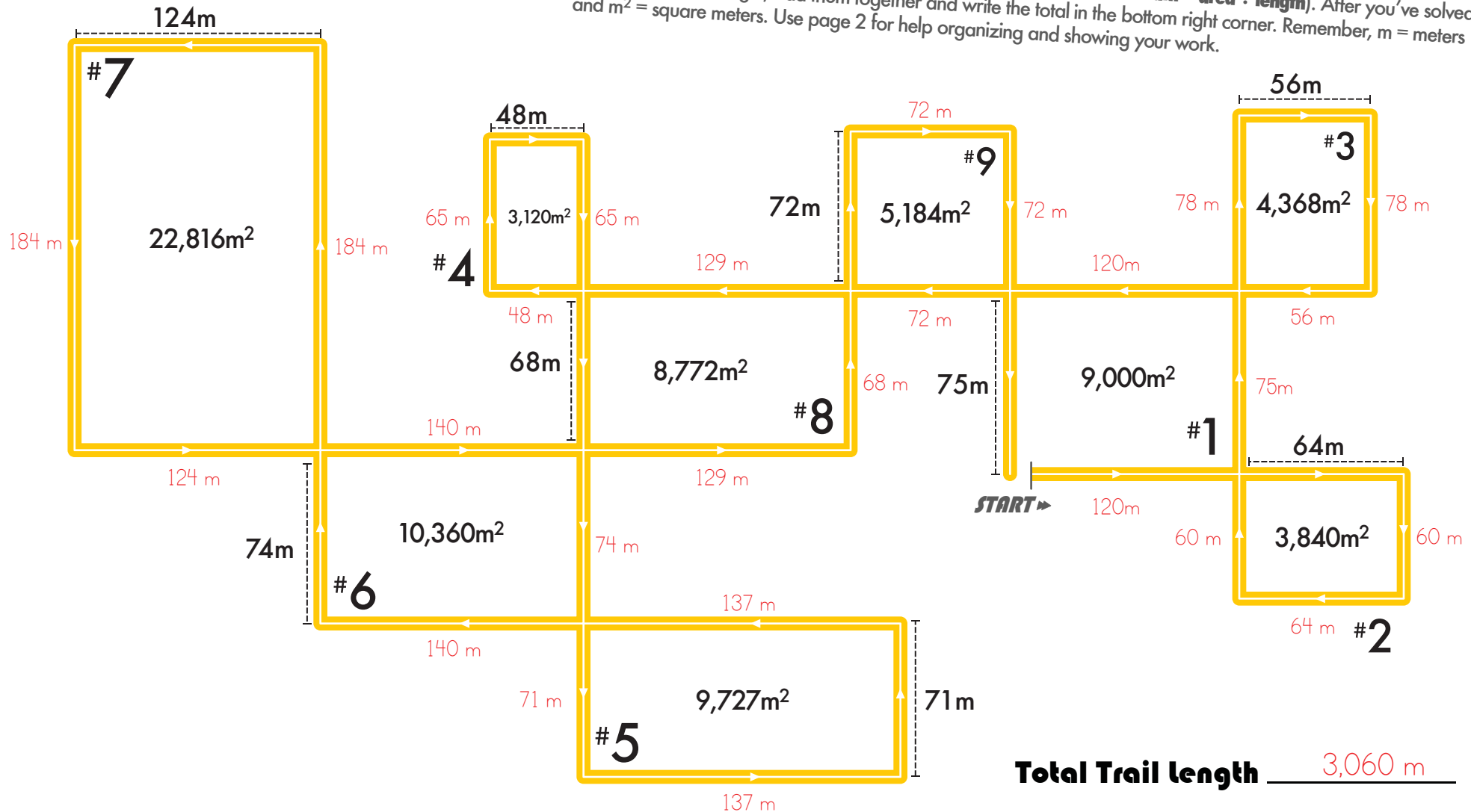


ski trail tracker #5

Find the total length of the cross-country ski trail below by finding the length of the individual segments. In each rectangular loop, the area and one side length are given. Use division to find the length of each unmarked segment (**rectangle area = length x width**, so **length = area ÷ width** or **width = area ÷ length**). After you've solved for each segment length, add them together and write the total in the bottom right corner. Remember, m = meters and m² = square meters. Use page 2 for help organizing and showing your work.

Use this page to organize your work and find the lengths of the missing segments on page 1. Refer to page 1 for the corresponding rectangle number and solve for the missing length or width using division. To find the total length of the trail, you can add up the individual lengths one by one, or you can solve for the perimeter of each rectangle and find the sum the perimeters. Either way, you will get the same answer!

#1 Length = 75m
Width = 120m
Area = 9,000m²

$$\begin{array}{r} 120 \\ 75 \overline{)9000} \\ \underline{-75} \\ 150 \\ \underline{-150} \\ 0 \end{array}$$

Perimeter = 390 m
 $75+120+75+120 = 390$

#2 Length = 60 m
Width = 64m
Area = 3,840m²

$$\begin{array}{r} 60 \\ 64 \overline{)3840} \\ \underline{-384} \\ 00 \\ \underline{-00} \\ 0 \end{array}$$

Perimeter = 248 m
 $60+64+60+64 = 248$

#3 Length = 78 m
Width = 56m
Area = 4,368m²

$$\begin{array}{r} 78 \\ 56 \overline{)4368} \\ \underline{-392} \\ 448 \\ \underline{-448} \\ 0 \end{array}$$

Perimeter = 144 m
 $78+56+78+56 = 268$

#4 Length = 65 m
Width = 48m
Area = 3,120m²

$$\begin{array}{r} 65 \\ 48 \overline{)3120} \\ \underline{-288} \\ 240 \\ \underline{-240} \\ 0 \end{array}$$

Perimeter = 226 m
 $65+48+65+48 = 226$

#5 Length = 71m
Width = 137 m
Area = 9,727m²

$$\begin{array}{r} 137 \\ 71 \overline{)9727} \\ \underline{-71} \\ 262 \\ \underline{-213} \\ 497 \\ \underline{-497} \\ 0 \end{array}$$

Perimeter = 416 m
 $137+71+137+71 = 416$

#6 Length = 74m
Width = 140 m
Area = 10,360m²

$$\begin{array}{r} 140 \\ 74 \overline{)10360} \\ \underline{-74} \\ 296 \\ \underline{-296} \\ 00 \end{array}$$

Perimeter = 214 m
 $140+74+140+74=214$

#7 Length = 184 m
Width = 124m
Area = 22,816m²

$$\begin{array}{r} 184 \\ 124 \overline{)22816} \\ \underline{-124} \\ 1041 \\ \underline{-992} \\ 496 \\ \underline{-496} \\ 0 \end{array}$$

Perimeter = 616 m
 $184+124+184+124 = 616$

#8 Length = 68m
Width = 129 m
Area = 8,772m²

$$\begin{array}{r} 129 \\ 68 \overline{)8772} \\ \underline{-68} \\ 197 \\ \underline{-136} \\ 612 \\ \underline{-612} \\ 0 \end{array}$$

Perimeter = 394 m
 $129+68+129+68 = 394$

#9 Length = 72m
Width = 72 m
Area = 5,184m²

$$\begin{array}{r} 72 \\ 72 \overline{)5184} \\ \underline{-504} \\ 144 \\ \underline{-144} \\ 0 \end{array}$$

Perimeter = 288 m
 $72+72+72+72 = 288$
