

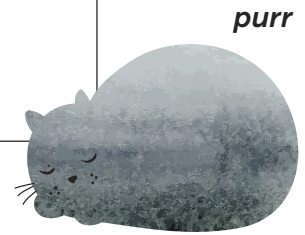
# Adding Adjectives: Sound
