SPELLING RULES FOR SUFFIXES

A suffix is a word part that is added to the end of a root or base word. It changes the meaning of the word. There are spelling rules to follow when adding the suffixes -less, -ful, -y, or -ly.

SUFFIX	MEANING
-less	without
-ful	full of
-у	characterized by, like
-ly	characteristic of

SPELLING RULES

- 1. If the word ends in a consonant and -y, change it to i before adding the suffix.
 - **Example:** bounty → bountiful
- 2. Keep the -e before -less, -ful, -ly.

Drop the **-e** before **-y**. **Example:** use → useless **Example:** laze → lazy
