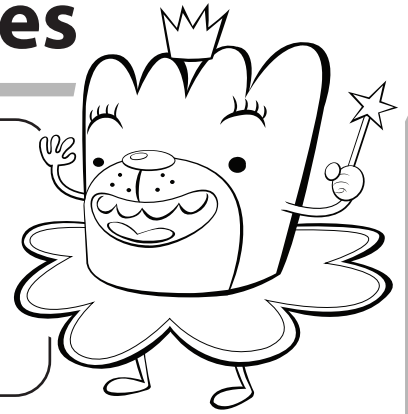


# Story Elements in Sentences

Story elements in a fictional story include:

- **characters:** The people or creatures in a story, movie, or play.
- **setting:** The time and place in which something happens.
- **problem:** A question or situation that is difficult to deal with.
- **solution:** The way to fix a problem.

The setting is the backyard.

The problem is that the dog was lost and could not find his way home.  
(character, setting, problem, solution)

3. Their kite got stuck in a tree.

The problem is that the kite is stuck in the tree.  
(character, setting, problem, solution)

4. Peter enjoyed his day.

The character is Peter.  
(character, setting, problem, solution)

5. The fish are deep in the ocean.

The setting is deep in the ocean.  
(character, setting, problem, solution)

6. He found his way home.

The solution is that he found his way home.  
(character, setting, problem, solution)
