

# Super Superlatives

Superlatives are a form of an adjective or adverb that compares three or more things. For example, the word **short** tells something about one thing, **shorter** tells something about two things and **shortest** tells something about three or more things.

Some superlatives are made by adding -est to the end of a word, like **shortest** or **softest**. Others are made by adding "most" before the word, as in **most dangerous** or **most boring**.
