How does a federal judge get in office?	A federal judge must first be appointed by the president and then confirmed by a majority in the Senate.
How long can someone serve as a federal judge?	Federal judges are appointed for life.
THE SUPREME COURT	
What is the Supreme Court?	The Supreme Court is the highest court in the United States.
How many judges are on the Supreme Court? What are they called?	There are nine judges on the Supreme Court. These judges are called Supreme Court Justices.
What main power does the Supreme Court have? Describe this power.	The Supreme Court has the power of judicial review. It interprets whether any law or executive action violates the constitution. If the court decides that something is unconstitutional, it becomes illegal.
