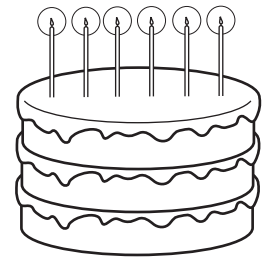

ability	the skill to do something.	Ability is being able to do something.	I have the ability to use neat handwriting on my homework.
explore	to make a careful search and learn about something.	To explore is to look for something and learn about it.	It was neat to explore the hole and learn about the fossils.
