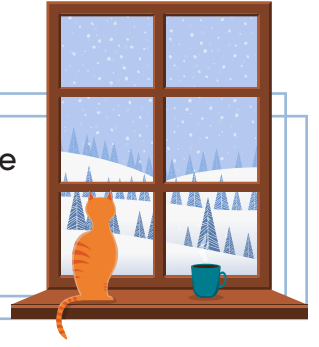


# WINTER HINK PINK RIDDLES
