

Word Pattern Analogies

Level 3

Words with **prefixes** and **suffixes** follow patterns. These patterns help us figure out the meanings of words. Here are some examples.

violin : violin**ist**

A violinist is a *person who* plays a violin.

guitar : guitar**ist**

A guitarist is a *person who* plays a guitar.
