When did it happen?	Information about time or occasion	The Boston Tea Party took place in 1773.
Where did it happen?	Information about location or place	The event was in the Boston Harbor.
Why did it happen?	Information about the reason something exists or happened	Colonists were protesting the new tea taxes placed on them by the British king.
How did it happen?	Information about the way something is done	They threw chests of tea in the water.

ANSWERS The Colony of Roanoke - The End

The first colonial settlers struggled to survive. They had a hard time when they tried to establish the Roanoke Colony in North Carolina. One of the leaders, Sir Richard Grenville, left to go get supplies. He returned to the colony a year later, but no one was there. He went back to England, and left a few men on Roanoke Island to protect the land.



John White found a carved tree in 1587.



The colonial leader John White sailed back to Roanoke Colony.

In 1587, John White brought people to Roanoke Island. They did not find anyone there. The new people stayed in Roanoke Colony, and John White went back to England to ask for help.

When John White returned, no one was in Roanoke Colony. He saw the word "CROATOAN" carved into a tree. He was unsure where his people went. He wondered if there had been a fight with the local tribe. He wondered if they joined together and moved to a new place.
