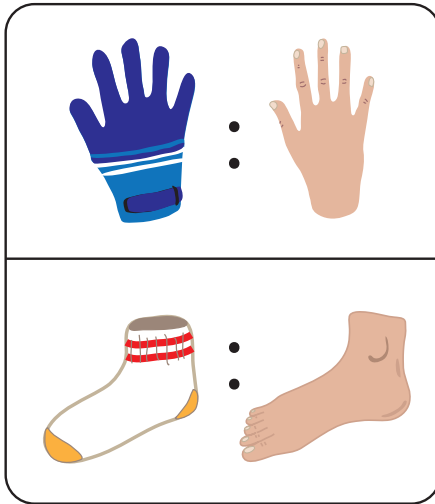
# Working with Analogies 2
