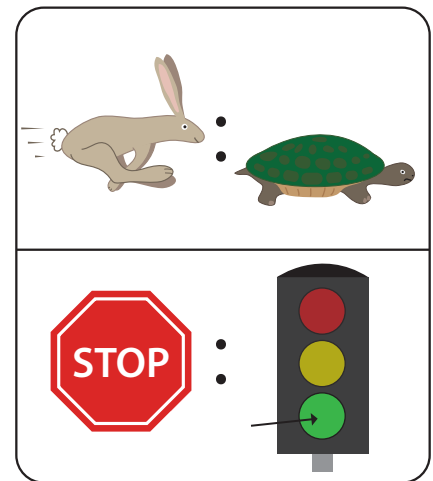
Working with Analogies 3
