Great Pyramid of Giza

TGAER YMIPARD FO IGAZ

Located in Egypt, it served as a tomb for the 4th dynasty Egyptian Pharaoh Khufu.



Temple of Artemis

MPLEET FO SATMREI

Built for the goddess of fertility, this massive structure is considered to be one of the largest temples constructed during the ancient times.



Hanging Gardens of Babylon
