Comparative adjectives compare two nouns. **Superlative adjectives** compare more than two nouns. When we write these adjectives, sometimes we have to follow special rules.



Adjective		Comparative	Superlative
One syllable	fast	Add -er: faster	Add -est: fastest
Ends in silent e	nice	Add -r: nicer	Add -st: nicest
Short vowel CVC word	big	Double the last consonant and add -er: bigger	Double the last consonant and add -est: biggest
Ends in -y	happy	Remove -y and add -ier: happier	Remove -y and add -iest: happiest
Two or more syllables	famous	Add more: more famous	Add most: most famous
Irregular	good	Change the spelling: better	Change the spelling: best
