# A Recipe for Transition Use

**Transition words**, much like bridges between your thoughts, help readers move from one idea to the next in an organized way.

Here are some helpful transitions for sequential writing: First... Second... Third... Next... Now... After... Later...

Directions: Read through the Unicorn Slime recipe two times.

#### Ingredients

### **Unicorn Slime**

- 1 bottle of Elmer's glitter glue 6 oz (pink, yellow, and blue for unicorn colors)
- Pink, gold, and blue glitter
- 1/2 TBSP of baking soda
- 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> TBSP of contact lens solution.
- Optional: Add 1 TBSP of water to the glue if you'd like a stretchier slime.

#### Instructions

- 1. Get a bowl.
- 2. Pour your entire 6 oz Elmer's Glitter glue into the bowl.
- 3. Add your 1/2 TBSP of baking soda and mix well.
- 4. Add the glitter color that matches the glue color, and continue to mix.
- 5. Slowly add in your contact lens solution.
- 6. Mix until your slime forms and begins to harden.
- 7. Take it out and knead it.
- 8. Repeat steps 1-7 for the other two colors.
- 9. Wind the three slimes together and you have your Unicorn Slime!
