For example: Judy talks *loudly*. (how)

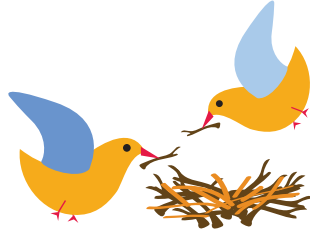
Susie goes to school *everyday*. (when)

Roy went *home*. (where)

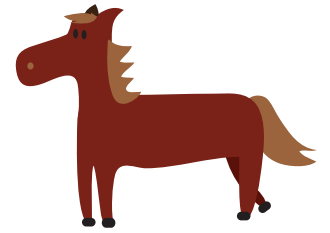

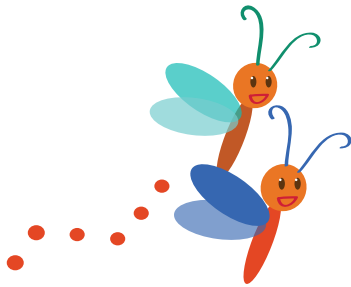

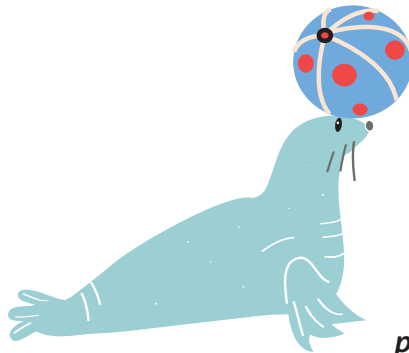
