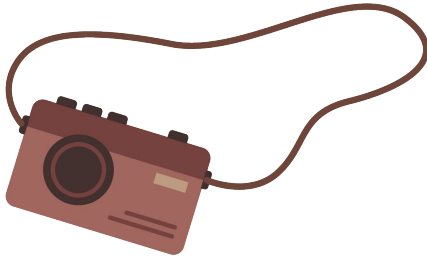


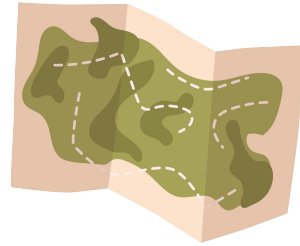
Adverbs

An adverb is a word that tells you more about a verb. It tells you **how**, **when**, or **where**.

Some adverbs tell you **how**. These usually end in **-ly**.

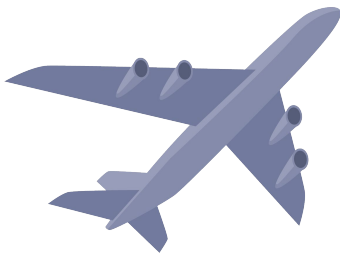


He **quickly** took the photo.

The plane leaves **now**.

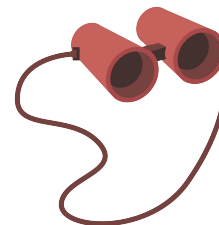


I packed my bags **yesterday**.
