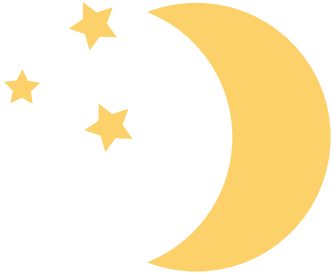


# Verbs and Adverbs #2

An adverb is a word that describes words other than nouns.  
Adverbs usually describe how, when, where, or to what extent.

For example: Judy talks *loudly*. (how)  
Susie goes to school *weekly*. (when)  
Roy went *home*. (where)
