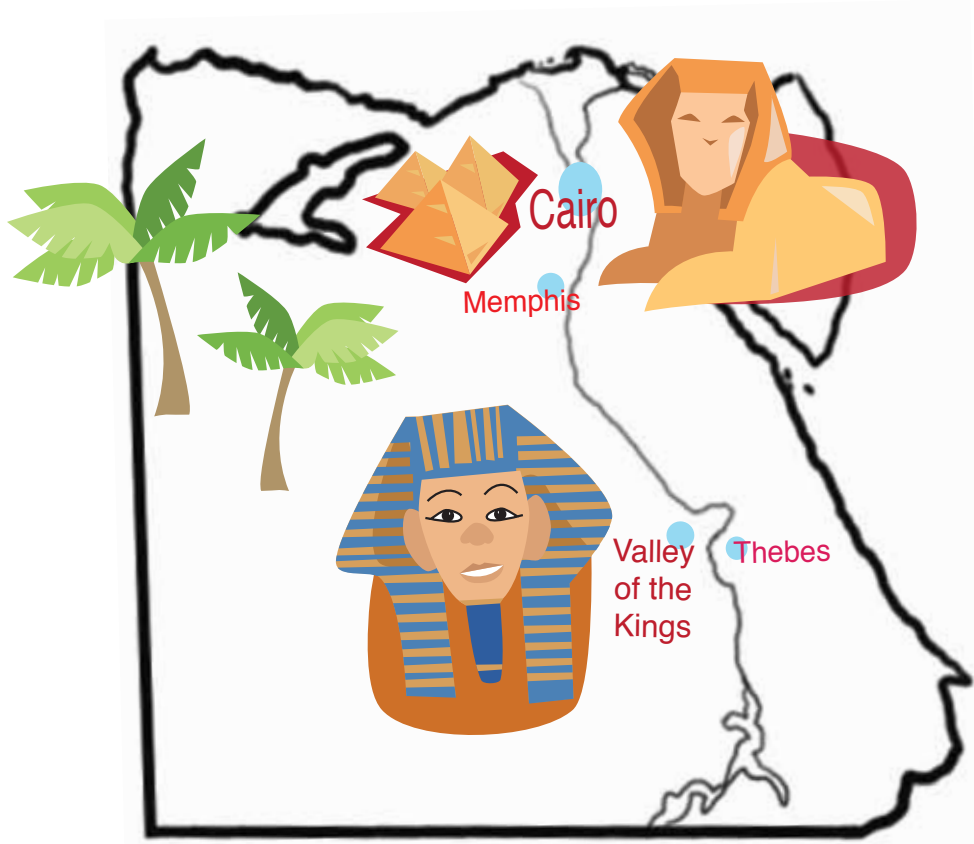


Map of Ancient Egypt
