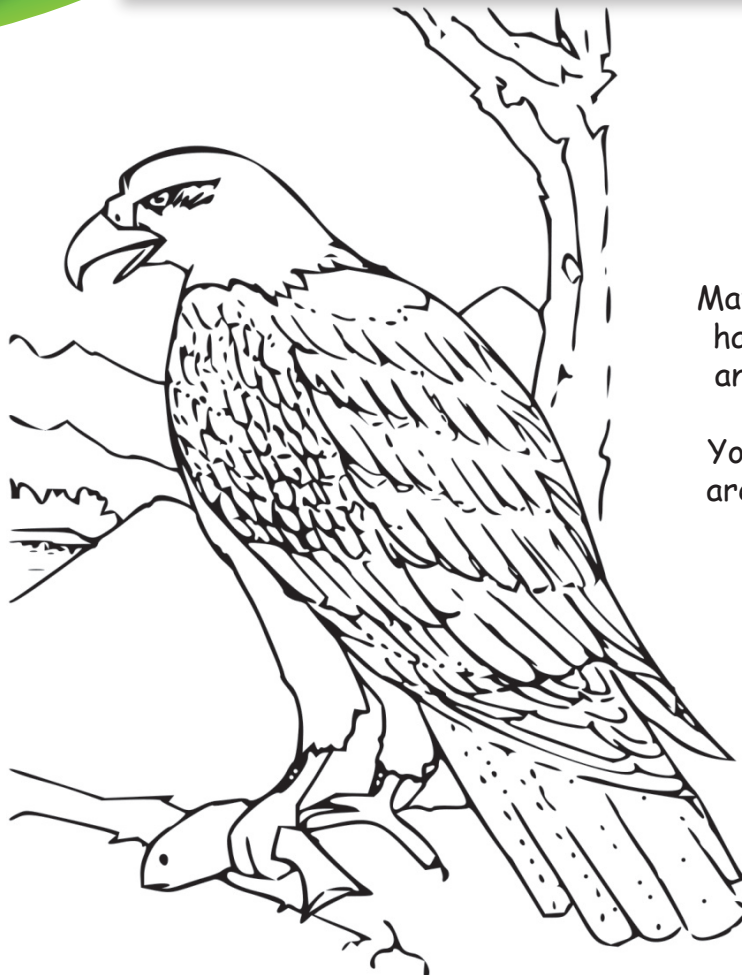
A: His feathers are combed over to one side.
