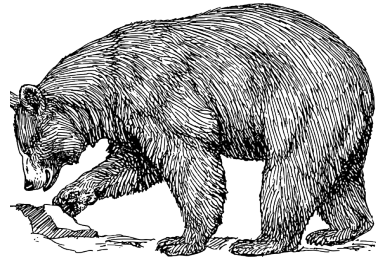


North American Animal Tracks

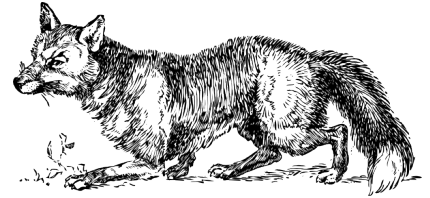
While walking through the woods you may not see any wild animals, but you might see signs that they've been there. Check the soft ground like sand, mud or snow for animal tracks. Then be a track detective! Mammals of the dog and cat families walk on four toes. Bears, raccoons, and rodents, like mice and squirrels, walk on five toes. Some animals have padded paws, some have claws, and others have hooves. These animals are all **North American Mammals**.

Write the letter in the box next to the correct tracks.



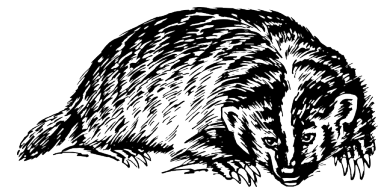
a. Black Bear



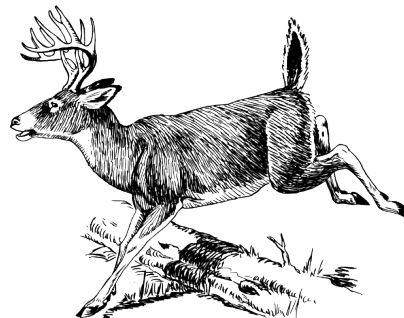
b. Red Fox
