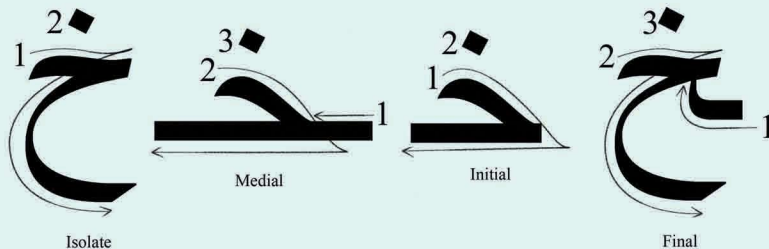


Learn the Arabic Alphabet!
